


Resource 1

Look at the resource below, which shares more information about libraries and what they are.



A library usually has a librarian, which is a person who works there. Librarians can help us to choose a good book to borrow. They keep the library organised too!





Some libraries have a comfy seating area so you can stay, snuggle up and enjoy your book in the library if you don't want to take it home.



You will find a fiction and non-fiction section in a library. Do you prefer fiction or non-fiction books?



Books and other materials are organised in a library, making them easier to find. Often books will be grouped depending on what they are about and the author's name will be used to help put it into alphabetical order.



Once you have found a book you want to borrow, you can scan the barcode in it and take it home. When you have finished it, you can return it.



Libraries often provide access to computers and the internet with space for people to sit and work.



Many libraries run special events or activities such as story time or reading challenges.
