



Classes 3 & 4 took part in a Stone Age day earlier this week. They looked at artefacts, completed cave art and made their own Stone Age mirror. They really enjoyed this enrichment activity.

On Tuesday 2nd October all children in the school will be taking part in Archaeology activities with the Nidderdale Archaeology Group. Each class will have their own slot where they will be excavating. Please can the children bring: a set of old warm clothes to change into; a waterproof coat; wellingtons or boots; and a hat and gloves. The children may well get muddy.

We have had a message from Nidderdale swimming baths, where the children go swimming, to ask us to remind you about what is needed for swimming on a Friday. All children need to have a swimming hat to wear, and their swim wear must be appropriate for lessons, they don't want any bikinis for example.

On Wednesday the 24th of October Miss Rogers' and Miss Wray's classes (Class 1 and Class 2) will be going on a trip to Harlow Carr in Harrogate, with the children from Grewelthorpe Primary School. This trip is directly linked to the children's science theme of 'animals including humans' and includes a guided workshop. The trip will take place within the normal school day and the children will be transported by Abbotts Coaches.

Mrs Nelson will provide the children with a packed lunch, if your child doesn't require a school packed lunch can you please let us know to avoid us wasting food. As the trip is in October can we please ask that children are dressed appropriately for the weather including a warm coat and sensible footwear. The children can wear non-uniform but must wear their school jumper or cardigan.

The entire cost of this trip is being covered by the Friends of Fountains, we do however need a consent form for each child to be returned to school in order for them to be able to go on the trip. The consent form is attached.
