Race Schedule

There is no specific race start times as this will depend on the progress of the morning. **The first race will begin at 4:00pm with the Year 3 Boys.** Races will then continue with Year 3 Girls, Year 4 Boys and finally Year 4 Girls.

The races should roughly be starting every 15 to 20 minutes. Please listen carefully to any race announcements that may be made. We recommend that you pay attention to the race order to make sure you are ready for your race. When your race is called, please make your way to the athlete drop off area. During the event, please look to spectate from behind the red tape, do not attempt to go onto the track. Please ensure that we only have teachers and competitors in the drop off and collection areas. Participants must take care when racing to avoid colliding with others, pushing, striking, or physically restricting other runners will not be accepted and may result in disqualification.

Facilities

Entrance will be via the gate next to the Hockey Club, please note the Hockey Club facility is closed to Cross Country runners. There are toilets available via the Sportshall entrance however please be aware of the busy carpark and other users. There is first aid provision by staff, please do not hesitate to use this.
